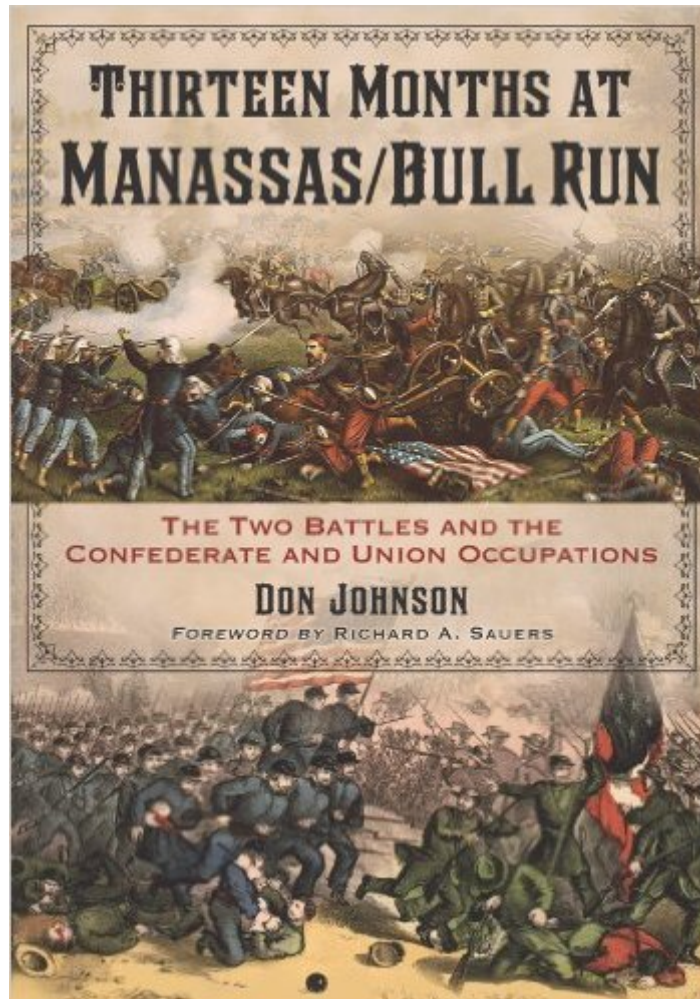


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Thirteen Months At Manassas/Bull Run: The Two Battles And The Confederate And Union Occupations



Synopsis

This Civil War history focuses on Prince William County, Virginia, where two of the war's greatest engagements were fought, thirteen months apart.
