

This book is a mixture of basic advice and tools along with some academic information designed to help teachers instruct a Down Syndrome child most effectively. There are statements in it that will give you insight into Down Syndrome children and adults and how they think and what they perceive and what they go through. There is a good simple section on the physical characteristics of a DS child which consolidates a lot of what is written out there. The author talks about teaching a DS child around these physical limitations and it all makes sense. The subtitle for this book is "Understanding how children with Down Syndrome learn." This is an older book, but it is filled with good ideas for both a teacher and a parent who wants to maximize their efforts in teaching a DS child. It includes a bibliography and some websites that have tools. One of them Woodbine House is a publishing house for books that deal with disabilities and they have a nice selection for DS as well as other disabilities.

I have worked with a child with Down Syndrome for 6 years and didn't realize a lot of what I thought were his little quirks were actually very characteristic of children with Down Syndrome. I have learned a lot since I started reading this book. I would recommend it to anyone that will or is working with Down Syndrome students.
