The communications of Marcos are amazing! Really great to read. This is a compilation of those texts, so the content is good. However, the selected writings could have been better. More than once the first part of a series is missing, which makes it hard to understand the following reactions. It also only contains the official communication. Most of the times Marcos reacts or refers to things that happened in Chiapas or Mexico, but the book never contains a small explanation of what was going on in Mexico at that time. This can make it hard for readers who are new to the EZLN and the situation in Chiapas. I had the impression some important communications were missing, f.i. I found nothing at all regarding the massacre of Acteal. And even weirder is that the 6th declaration of the Lacandon is missing. It would have been nice if it contained some more images...

This book is an amazing collection of one of Latin America's greatest living writers and activists, Subcomandante Marcos (who I, incidentally, think is one of the sexiest men in the world!!!
